### BOLLARD GAMES

#### Bollard Jumps

Start at the elephant bollard. How many long jumps does it take for you to touch the bollards on the other side? The person with the lowest number of jumps is the winner. Remember this game does not include walking or running, only jumping.

#### Bollard Decathlon

Start on one side: bollard weave, along the benches, up and down the stage, run to the other side, bollard weave, run back, up and down the stage, along the benches, bollard weave, home.

#### More than Bollards

How many different bollards are there? Do the shapes remind you of anything else? Draw a picture, turning the bollard into something else.

### GET CREATIVE

#### What's in a Name?

Why do you think this area is called Frog Marsh? Make up a story to tell us why.


#### Ssssh!

Sit on the stage and listen. Now draw all the things you can hear. What does your soundscape look like?

#### Frog Marsh on Film

Using a stop motion app, try taking a photo of someone standing on one side of Frog Marsh. Keeping the camera as still as possible, get them to move just a little bit towards the other side and take another photo. Repeat this about ten times and then play it back on the app. Try some different poses, add other people or objects!

### STAGE GAMES

#### The World's a Stage

Write a poem, make up a song, use the stage to share it with the world.

#### Speaker's Corner

A speaker's corner is a place for public speeches and debates. What's important to you, what do, or don't you like about Bristol, what do you want other people to know? Use the stage to spread the word.

#### Frog Marsh Statues

The stage is the plinth and you are the statue. Person A gets up and freezes into a pose, person B comes on to the stage and freezes in response to the first person's pose (e.g. if person A is doing a Karate Chop, Person B could try and defend themselves). Person A unfreezes and steps down, then Person C comes up on the stage and gets into a pose that responds to Person B's pose, and so on.
